The purpose of this public hearing is for the Village Board to receive public testimony in reference to the proposed 2011 property tax levy.

The tax levy as proposed by Village Staff has been and will continue to be available for inspection in the Village Clerk's office.

This hearing may be adjourned to another date without further notice other than a motion to be entered upon the minutes of this meeting fixing the time and place of its adjournment.

All interested parties are invited to sign in for the purpose of providing testimony.

Notice of this Public Hearing for the 2011 property tax levy was published on November 23, 2011, in the Streamwood Examiner.

Village Clerk Kittie Kopitke stated no written testimony was received.

Finance Director Mary Johnson stated the Village 2010 extended tax levy was \$9,484,979 and the proposed 2011 tax levy (payable in 2012) is \$9,548,829 which is an increase of 0.7%. This increase is the dollar amount necessary to meet the Village's pension obligations required by state law.

Trustee Patterson moved to adjourn the Public Hearing. Trustee Carlson seconded the motion. A voice vote was unanimous for approval. The Public Hearing adjourned at 6:54 p.m.
