

MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING
REGARDING THE PROPOSED RENEWAL OF THE CABLE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT
WITH COMCAST OF ILLINOIS XI, LLC

March 15, 2018 – 6:30 pm

This proceeding is called pursuant to the requirements of the Federal Cable Communication Policy Act and their request to renew their franchise agreement between Comcast of Illinois XI, LLC, a current cable television franchisee and the Village of Streamwood.

Notice of this hearing was published in the *Streamwood Examiner* on February 14, 2018.

The purpose of this hearing is to afford the public the opportunity to offer comment and insight in order to:

Identify future cable-related community needs and interests of the residents of the Village of Streamwood; and

Review the performance of Comcast of Illinois XI, LLC under its current cable television franchise.

Mr. Mike Paulos was present representing Comcast of Illinois XI, LLC.

Note: Trustee Baumer arrived 6:35 p.m. Trustee Harper arrived 6:37 p.m.

Mr. Paulos stated Comcast has been presenting at public hearings to initiate informal renewal processes in anticipation of their current franchise agreement expiring in 2020. He reviewed a variety of the updated Comcast services and improvements, and noted a number of upcoming improvements scheduled for later in 2018, including increased internet speed. He also noted additional products including X-Fi, Xfinity mobile products and X-Home for security and “smart” home features.

There were no specific questions from the Board regarding the future cable television related needs of the Village of Streamwood, the performance of Comcast of Illinois XI, LLC under its current cable television franchise agreement, or the proposed renewal of said franchise.

No one in the audience signed in or requested to give testimony on the future cable television related needs of the Village of Streamwood, the performance of Comcast of Illinois XI, LLC under its current cable television franchise agreement or the proposed renewal of said franchise.

Village Clerk Kittie Kopitke received no written comments or testimony on this matter.

Trustee Carlson moved to adjourn. Trustee Cecille seconded the motion. A voice vote approved the adjournment. The Village Board adjourned the Public Hearing at 6:49 p.m.
