The purpose of this public hearing is for the Village Board to receive public testimony in reference to the proposed 2014 property tax levy.

The tax levy as proposed by Village Staff has been and will continue to be available for inspection in the Village Clerk's office.

This hearing may be adjourned to another date without further notice other than a motion to be entered upon the minutes of this meeting fixing the time and place of its adjournment.

All interested parties are invited to sign in for the purpose of providing testimony.

Notice of this Public Hearing for the 2014 property tax levy was published on November 12, 2014, in the Streamwood Examiner.

Village Clerk Kittie Kopitke confirmed there was no written testimony received. No one has signed in to provide verbal testimony at this Public Hearing.

Finance Director Mary Johnson stated the Village Board will be considering two tax levies later this evening. One tax levy covers general tax purposes, and the levy equals the 2013 tax extension. Payment for debt service has decreased, and the overall proposed 2014 tax levy is one-half of one percent lower than 2013 tax levy. The second levy is for the Village's special service areas, specific to each subdivision, with the amount equal to the needs of the individual areas to be maintained within those subdivisions.

Trustee Patterson moved to adjourn. Trustee Carlson seconded the motion. A voice vote approved the adjournment. The Village Board adjourned the Public Hearing at 6:54 p.m.
