The tax levy as proposed by Village Staff has been and will continue to be available for inspection in the Village Clerk’s office.

This hearing may be adjourned to another date without further notice other than a motion to be entered upon the minutes of this meeting fixing the time and place of its adjournment.

All interested parties are invited to sign in for the purpose of providing testimony.

Notice of this Public Hearing for the 2015 Tax Levy was published on November 11, 2015 in the *Streamwood Examiner*.

Village Clerk Kittie Kopitke stated no one has provided written testimony; no one has signed in to provide verbal testimony at the Public Hearing.

Finance Director Mary Johnson stated the proposed tax levy is equal to last year’s extension with no increase in the total taxes to be levied. Pension levy dollars have increased, but the general tax levy was decreased to allow for no levy increase for 2016. Ms. Johnson noted the Equalized Assessed Valuation (EAV) for real property has risen slightly in the last year which is a good economic sign.

Trustee Baumer moved to adjourn the Public Hearing. Trustee Cecille seconded the motion. A voice vote approved the adjournment. The Village Board adjourned the Public Hearing at 6:49 p.m.
