Finance Director Josh Peacock stated the 2019 Budget proposal is a direct result of the Board's Goals and Objectives for 2019. The Village tax rate is remaining flat and the proposed budget includes investment in the community with two event signs and planning infrastructure for connecting pathways within the Village.
